#### 2. Summary of the programme

# **Narra Germination Program**

Every year the school plan to germinate 10 000 seedlings of Narra Trees. The plan involves all the members of the CNHS. The germinated seeds will be used in the tree planting activities of the school. It is the goal of the school to build a seedling bank of Narra trees to those who would like to plant Narra trees in their homes or even in the community. It is used for an income generating project to raise funds to support school activities. The school also planned to encourage environmentalists to support the program from all stakehoders.

#### **Narra Germination Process**

Narra Trees (Pterocarpus Indicus) have their flowers bloom from the month of January to March. They have small bunches of yellow flowers. After that blooming stage it will start to bear seeds. The seeds starts with a green puds and matured into brown for four months. When it becomes a full grown seeds, it will just fall from the tree.

The germination started by picking up those matured seeds and placing that in a seed beds. The seeds is planted in a vertical position. After three months the seedlings will be replanted in a polythethelene bag. It takes again another three months for the seedlings to be ready for replanting.
